KISAN DIWAS – Awareness programme on Vikasit Bharat G RAM G programme for farmers and other stakeholders

On 23rd December 2025, commemorating the birth anniversary of Bharat Ratna Shri Chaudhary Charan Singh, to honour the invaluable contribution of farmers to the nation's economy and food security, KISAN Diwas was organized at ICAR-Indian Institute of Oilseeds Research (ICAR-IIOR), Rajendranagr, Hyderabad.
